

CAIRNRYAN-LARNE-CAIRNRYAN DAY OF TRAVEL INFORMATION PACK FOR COACH & GROUPS

(LAST UPDATED: 02/05/24)



- **Please be ready for your arrival at the port with the following:**
 - 1.) You have the correct booking reference number
 - 2.) A completed copy of a Group Passenger List including your booking reference number, passenger breakdown including drivers/couriers and vehicle registration number.

- **P&O Ferries check-in opens 2 Hours and closes 45 minutes prior to departure, we advise you arrive at the port no later than 60 minutes to sailing to allow time to process all checks.**

- **If travelling onboard with a coach then follow the signs, you will then proceed to the P&O Ferries check-in booths. Once checked-in, you will be directed to the relevant lane ready for embarkation. Post code for the Port of Cairnryan is DG9 8RF and Post code for the Port of Larne is BT40 1AW**

- **If you are travelling onboard without a coach then follow the signs, you will then proceed to the P&O Ferries terminal building. Once checked-in, you will be directed to the relevant area ready for embarkation. You will board a shuttle bus for both embarkation and disembarkation, please note any luggage will be loaded onto baggage trolleys which will be ready to collect upon disembarkation.**

- **Upon the ship arrival in Cairnryan or Larne, please do not congregate at the top of stairways to the vehicle decks until called forward for disembarkation. If you require any assistance during your crossing, then please speak to one of our onboard team or the Information Office.**
