

TRAVELLING TO AN EU COUNTRY OR NORTHERN IRELAND WITH YOUR PET?

YOU CAN NO LONGER USE A PET PASSPORT ISSUED IN GREAT BRITAIN

When travelling to an EU country or Northern Ireland, your dog, cat or ferret needs:

- a microchip
- a valid rabies vaccination
- an animal health certificate unless you have a pet passport issued in an EU country or Northern Ireland
- tapeworm treatment for dogs if you're travelling directly to Finland, Ireland, Northern Ireland, Norway or Malta

These requirements also apply to assistance dogs.

Contact your vet at least one month in advance of travel.

Check the rules of the country you're travelling to for any additional restrictions or requirements before you travel. Always check the latest COVID-19 travel guidance.
